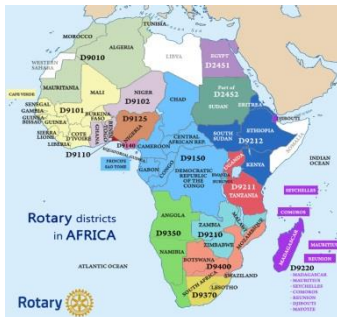

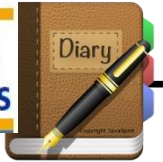

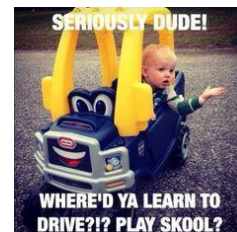
THREE NEW CLUB INDUCTIONS TONIGHT!

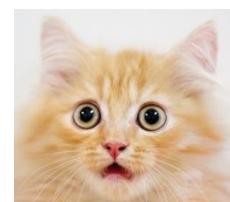

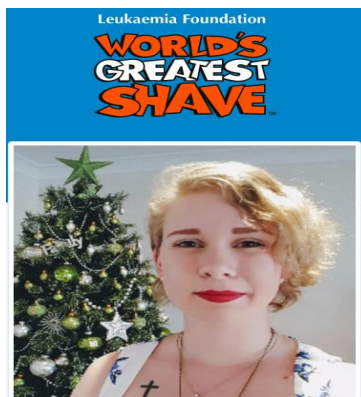
