A year ago, George Grant was inducted as District-Governor of Rotary District 9600. Now, a year on, after hundreds of dinners and meetings and trips around the District (including to PNG and Solomon Islands), his year as DG has come to an end.

His wife Mary's project has raised enough money for 5 scholarships to be awarded to indigenous students studying in health fields, each worth \$5000, which is a fantastic result.

As for the PNG HPV project, the results are rather mind blowing! 11 Rotary clubs across Australia and the US have donated funds in support of the project totalling \$329,500! That means that 23,000 school-aged girls in PNG will receive the HPV vaccine in the first year of the project and another 5000 girls in the second year. This project will be monitored by the PNG government and organisations such as UNICEF and WHO with a view to expand the project throughout PNG in future years. PNG has one of the highest rates of cervical cancer in the world, so this project could quite literally save lives!

George and Mary are good friends of our Rotary Club; and we wish to say Thanks for a job well done!



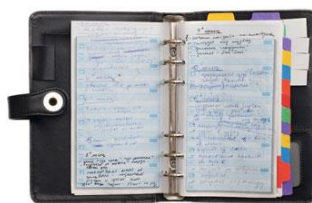

The Fortica Rehabilitation Centre in the coastal city of Kraljevica serves 50 children with severe disabilities from around the country. A Rotary Foundation grant project furnished the centre with new health care facilities, enabling it to address more medical issues on-site and reduce the number of hospital visits.

The effort undertaken by the Rotary Clubs of Gorizia, Italy and Rijeka, Croatia; and completed in 2014 – provided medical equipment and six beds for the new clinic and training for staff and parents. The Rijeka club has supported the centre since 1991, when the child of a local Rotarian was treated there. RC Rijeka was chartered in 1992 and has around 20 members, meeting at 8 p.m. on Mondays.
